


EDITORIAL

Welcome to the New Provincial

On 5 October 2018 Sr. Elizabeth George, the new Provincial arrived at Auxilium Convent Nongthymmai with cheers of young people who arrayed from the gate till the portico of the house. With colourful balloons in their hands they greeted the new leader of the Province. A solemn welcome was then accorded at the entrance of the house in the presence of all the Animators of the thirty communities of the Province, the Sisters from the nearby communities, Novices and Young people.



Donning on the Provincial the various traditional attires of the place marked the solemn welcome and initiation into the family. She was dressed with the Puan - a mizo lungi, the Nara a traditional waistband worn by women in Karbi Anglong, the Risa of the Tripuris, the Paila - a Khasi necklace, the Kotip - a Garo headgear and was presented a Bouquet of flowers with the names of the communities inscribed on it. All went to the Chapel for a solemn thanksgiving prayer and the melodious chorus of

the Magnificat. The bouquet of flowers was placed at the altar sign of offering every Sister and the entire educating community to the Lord.

Sr. Alphonsa Kurisinkal, Provincial of Guwahati Province along with many Animators accompanied Sr. Elizabeth from Guwahati. While a group of Sisters from Shillong received Sr. Elizabeth at Mawtnum Community and came up to Shillong.

Every new beginning comes from some other beginning's end. 6 October 2018 witnessed the passing on of a baton of animation from Sr. Isabella Suja to Sr. Elizabeth George. The momentous event was marked with a meaningful ceremony at the Holy Eucharistic Celebration presided over by Most Rev. Dominic Jala SDB, Archbishop of Shillong.

At the entrance procession, Sr. Elizabeth George approached the altar with a lighted candle symbolizing Christ the light of her journey of animation. Sr. Alphonsa Kurisinkal, Provincial of Guwahati along with all the former Provincials of both Shillong and Guwahati namely Sr. Ivy D' Souza, Sr. Phyllis Bamon, Sr. Rosa Pyngrope, Sr. Isabella Suja and Sr. Teresa Puthenpurackal accompanied her to the altar. During the homily, Archbishop Jala implored God's blessings on the new Provincial and the team. He also exhorted everyone present to live the charism of Don Bosco and Mother Mazzarello in a tangible way according to the signs of the time. Soon after the homily the ceremony of the Installation began wherein Sr. Isabella Suja read the Decree of nomination and entrusted the animation of the Province to Sr. Elizabeth George. A symbolic action of presenting the new Provincial with a key, which was later placed at the foot of Mary, was a reminder that Mary is the real Superior of the Province and Sr. Elizabeth is her representative in carrying out the mandate entrusted to her. In another expression of unity, support, collaboration, commitment and co-responsibility, representatives from the Sisters, Young People, Candidates, Salesian Co-operators and Past pupils each brought forward a rose and placed it near the key while the assembly sang the hymn entitled, "I entrust them to you". In response to the mandate given to her, Sr. Elizabeth publicly expressed her availability to do God's will and invited everyone to join her in the journey as she counts on the intelligent, responsible and sisterly co-operation of everyone in the Province.



The gathering was blessed by the presence of many Sisters from Guwahati Province. It was indeed a moment of closeness and unity in one big FMA Family in Northeast India. The meaningful liturgy prepared by the community of Nandan Nagar, Agartala and the melodious and devout choir of Auxilium Shillong gave a prayerful and heavenly touch to the day's celebration.

I greet each one of you affectionately as I take up my responsibility as the 12th Provincial of the Province of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Shillong. Extract from the last Circular Letter of Sr. Isabella Suja


Dearest Sisters,
